Package cost depends on the number of ancestors to be traced. All include:

- Family tree charts, that are easy-to-follow, visually displaying your ancestors and their relationships. Many clients display these on their walls.
- Personalised family tree book, presenting the findings. Extra copies can also be purchased and all include:
 - ✓ In-depth information on each ancestor researched, such as when and where they were born, married and died; where they lived; what occupations or trades they worked in and how history impacted on their lives. Depending on the person, it might also include information like where they went to school, if they served in the military, or committed a crime. Perhaps they were in the workhouse or awarded a medal.
 - ✓ Comprehensive research report detailing the entire genealogy research process, including the sources used and methodology employed. This is the proof that the people researched are your ancestors.
 - Transcripts and copies of the sources used, including census records, birth extracts, parish register entries, and wills, providing evidence of the information discovered.
 - Glossary of genealogy and historic terms and abbreviations, allowing you to understand the language of the past.
 - You can include details about your immediate family, so they too can appear in the book and on the chart(s) and you can add photographs from your own collection.
- Main goal of tracing back 200 years, to the late-1700s or early-1800s, depending on surviving records, with option to add research back further, if possible (extra fees apply).
- A valuable resource for understanding and preserving your family history for future generations and a sense of connection and pride in your family's heritage.

The packages are complete in themselves and make a wonderful book, but if you wish to add more research, such as trying to work as far back as possible, do contacting me for further information.

Packages trace your **ancestors**. The names of their siblings are included, but siblings are not traced forward.

How It Works

- 1. Choose your package and contact me to pay the deposit. This reserves your research slot and allows the work to start. I accept bank transfers, cheques and debit or credit cards via PayPal.
- 2. I send a form for you to complete which gathers what you know already. Don't worry if that is very little, as I start where your own knowledge ends. Return before the agreed start date.
- 3. I conduct the research, obtaining the required documents like birth certificates, census records and parish register entries. I will update you at roughly weekly intervals. It takes about 6 weeks for the 1 and 2 surname packages; about 10 for the larger packages. In the rare event that the family can't be traced, I will discuss options like full/partial refund or following an alternative line.
- 4. Towards the end, I will start writing up the project and send some documents to you to check. Once agreed, I will arrange the project to be bound. The four surname and pedigree packages include a draft book too.
- 5. The balance is due just before the project is posted. It is sent via first class post. If there are any errors, I offer a free-of charge reprint. Extra copies can be ordered if required.


